5. Agenda Items from Actions of previous Minutes

5.1 Demonstration Catchment Project Update:

DM: The CJP-WP work crew has carried out lots of work and great progress is being made.

5.2 N4C Premises update: Lower floor stormwater drainage & nursery area

DM: All the benches are now complete and the area is now ready to store plants. N4C now has the ability to buy large numbers of plants and be able to store them over the winter period. Good size plants can often be in short supply over the winter period. N4C now also has the ability to size up small plants by keeping them in storage.

5.3 CJP – WP project update

DM took the opportunity to thank Paulina for the professional way the interviews were carried out in relation to the CJP and for her assistance in helping to run the CJP-WP Program. The participants are developing into a good team and achieving great results.

5.4 Birdwood Rd private property/Norman Ck rehabilitation plan & costing

DM: Waiting on Ken McClymont to produce costings for the rehab and restoration of the site.

5.5 March 28th 2005 Submission Draft SEQ Regional Plan

DM read out the submission sent in on behalf of N4C. Confirmation of receipt has been received.

5.6 15th February 2005 Norman Ck Catchment WMP W/S @ GU Eco-Centre

Four N4C members attended making up 57% of the community participants to the workshop. The lack of prior community consultation in the development of the draft WMP was stressed to Council officers attending the workshop.

5.7 Cleanup Australia event 6th March 2005.

DM: Had seven participants turn up to help clean up the creek at Moorhen Flats. Tony Cotter couldn't attend on the day due to family commitments. To make up for this Tony carried out his own clean up prior to the event. He cleaned up 37 bags worth of rubbish as well as a shopping trolley whilst working from the Stones Corner down to Turbo Drive. The cleanup collected 20 bags from Turbo Drive down to the tip at the confluence with Kingfisher Creek making a total of 57 bags of rubbish for the event– well done!

GJ announced that work is due to start on the pool directly below the freeway tunnel at Arnwood Place. DM also announced that there will be a Riverclean day at Arnwood place on 23rd August.
